In 2020 they competed at the European Tango Contest in Germany and at the Mundial de Baile of Buenos Aires.

In 2021 they were selected to study in the six months formation of the Tango Ballet "El Cxuce Tango" founded and directed by Vanesa Villalba and Facundo Piñero.
